

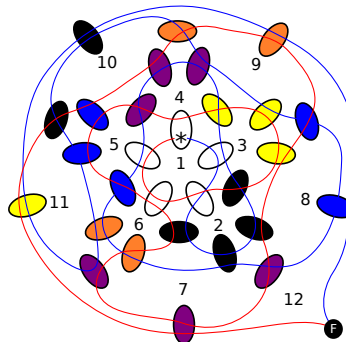
# Pattern + Tutorial Ball

Ball - Full Pattern

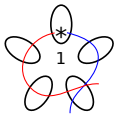


### Material Requirements:

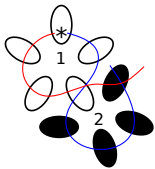
-  Seed beads 11/0 white
  -  Seed beads 11/0 black
  -  Seed beads 11/0 gold/yellow
  -  Seed beads 11/0 violet
  -  Seed beads 11/0 blue
  -  Seed beads 11/0 orange
- Nylon thread (0,20mm - 0,25mm),  
scissors  
optional: thread zap/lighter  
and wadding

### Step-by-step description:

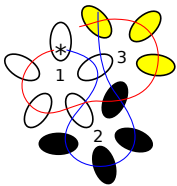
1) Take a nylon thread size 0,25 mm of length 40cm. Pick up 5 white beads on one end and cross through the last bead with the other end. Pull tight on both ends of the thread so that the first circle is in the middle of the thread.



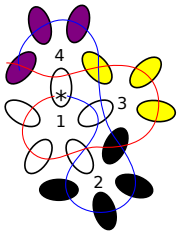
2) Pick up 4 black beads with the blue end, cross with the red end through the last black bead and pull tight on both ends.



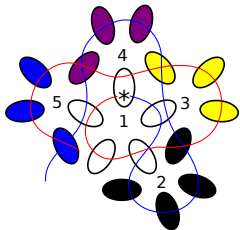
3) Go with the blue end through the closest white bead. Pick up 3 golden/yellow beads with the red end and cross through the last bead with the blue end. Pull tight on both ends.



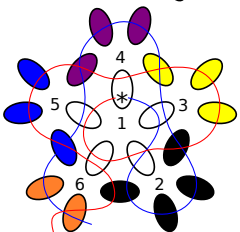
4) Go with the red end through the closest white bead. Pick up 3 violet beads with the blue end and cross through the last bead with the red end. Pull tight on both ends.



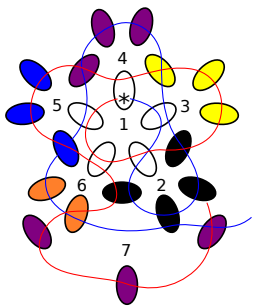
5) Go with the blue end through the closest white bead. Pick up 3 blue beads with the red end and cross through the last bead with the blue end. Pull tight on both ends.



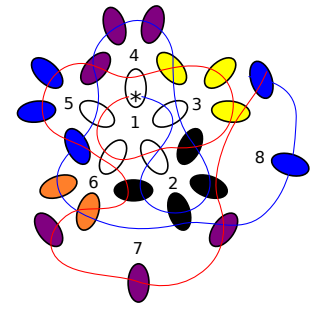
6) Go with the red end through the last white bead of circle 1 and through the closest black bead of circle 2. Pick up 2 orange beads with the blue end and cross through the last bead with the red end. Pull tight.



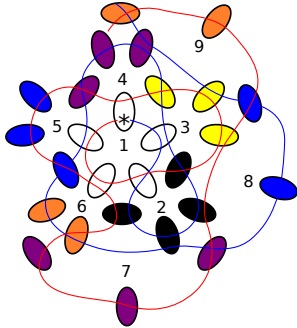

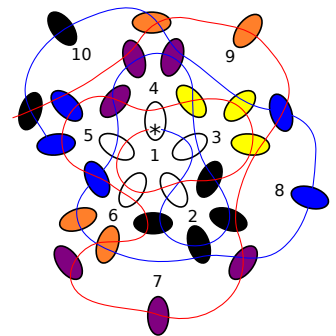
7) Go with the blue end through the closest black bead. Pick up 3 violet beads with the red end and cross through the last bead with the blue end. Pull tight on both ends.



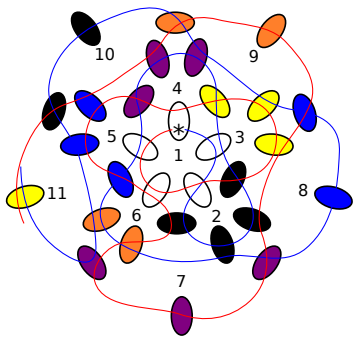
8) Go with the red end through the black bead and through the closest yellow bead. Pick up 2 blue beads with the blue end and cross through the last bead with the red end. Pull tight on both ends.



9) Go with the blue end through the yellow bead and through the closest violet bead. Pick up 2 orange beads with the red end and cross through the last bead with the blue end. Pull tight on both ends.

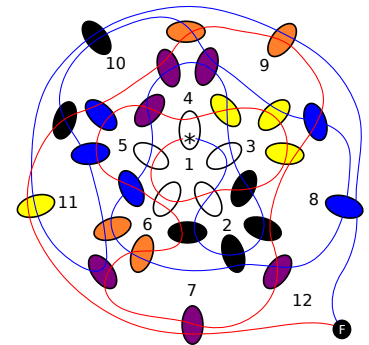


10) Go with the red end through the violet bead and through the closest blue bead. Pick up 2 black beads with the blue end and cross through the last bead with the red end. Pull tight on both ends.



11) Go with the blue end through the blue bead, then through the orange bead and finally through the violet bead. Pick up 1 yellow bead on the red end and cross through that bead with the blue end. Pull tight.

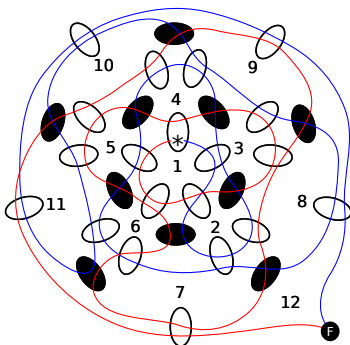
12) Last circle -only connect the loose beads.: Go with the red end through the violet bead and with the blue end through the black, orange and blue bead. Knot both ends and then cut the rest of.



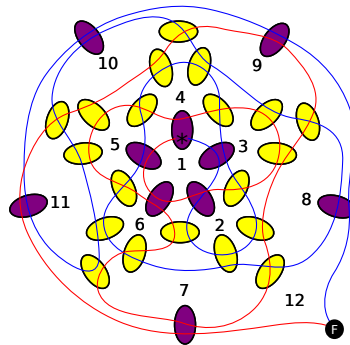
Your ball is finished!
